### Tornedde Services To Be Conducted Tuesday Evening

Last services for Ernest H. Tornedde, 79, resident of Peoria for almost 50 years, will be conducted by Mrs. Clinton Lee Scott, wife of the pastor of the First Universalist church, at 7 o'clock Tuesday evening at the Wilton Mortuary chapel.

Mr. Tornedde passed away at his home, 123 Steubenville street, at 7:50 o'clock Saturday evening. For many years he had operated a grocery store at that address.

The aged Peorian was born at Hanover, Germany, July 29, 1855, and came to this country in 1881, residing first in Ohio. He came to Peoria in 1884.

He was an iron moulder by trade and for 15 years after coming here he was foreman at the Washington foundry. After that time he established his store.

His marriage to Miss Martha Seitz took place in 1909. She survives her husband, with two daughters, Mrs. Martha Cannaday and Mrs. Hilda Nelson, and three grandchildren, all of Peoria. One son, Ernest L. Tornedde, died here June 7, 1933.
